Enrichment

Due to the impact of COVID-19 and school closures, the enrichment programming for the 2019-2020 academic year was curtailed.

ARTS: 3,000 children participated in 53 artists-in-residencies workshops and a related culminating event for their friends and families.

SPORTS: Students played 5,392 basketball, softball, flag football and soccer games.

STEM: 3,600 students participated in the Celebrate Science & Engineering Program.

HEALTH & WELLNESS: 2,000 lower grade students participated in Happy Healthy Me.

FIELD TRIPS: 2,682 students went on field trips.

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March 14 to June 30, 2020

When schools closed for in-person teaching, we had to abruptly halt our robust enrichment programming and focus on meeting the community's immediate needs and cultivating connections with our students, families and staff. We were unable to run our 2020 summer program for students.

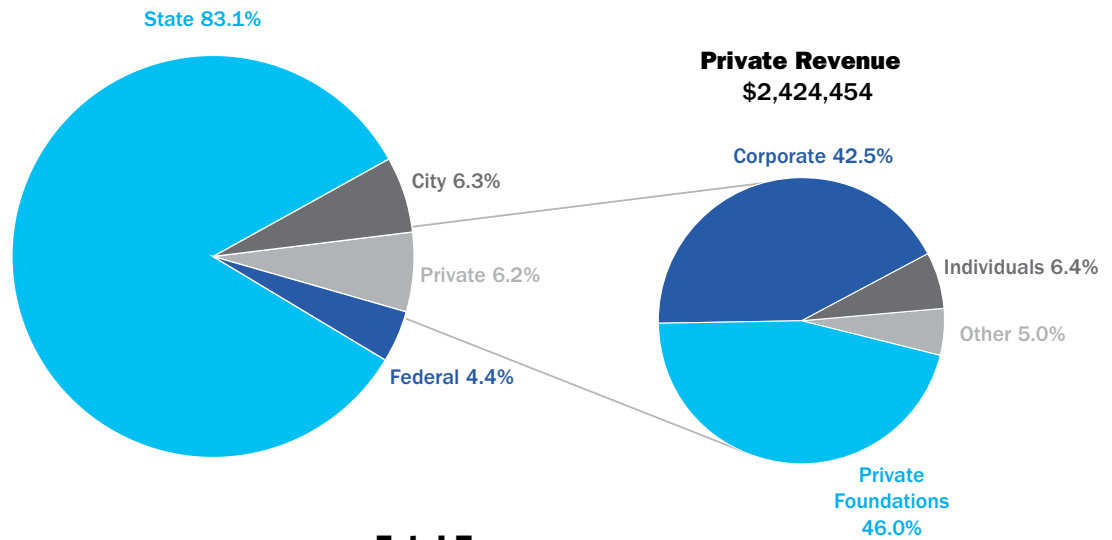
worked at the LAUSD and Beyond The Bell Grab & Go Food Distribution Centers.

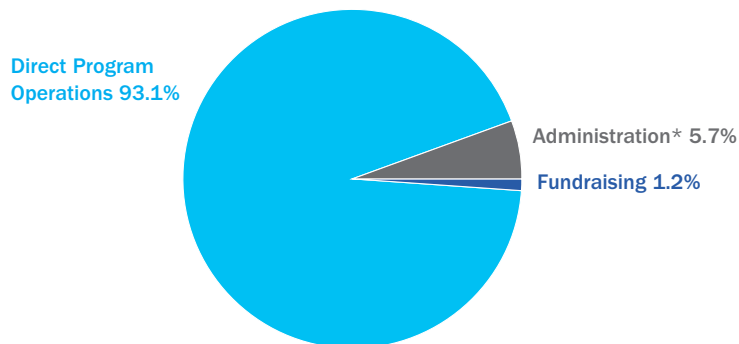
Revenues and Support
